

## WHAT TO BRING

Documents you will need to complete your 2018-2019 FAFSA. Not all items apply to every student. Bring only the things that apply to you.

- Your Social Security Number (shown on your Social Security card)
- Your parents' Social Security number (if applicable)
- Your alien registration card, if you are not a U.S. citizen
- W-2 forms, final 2016 paycheck stubs, or other records of money earned by you and your parents in 2016
- Your 2016 federal income tax return (and your spouse's return if you are married), if already prepared
- Your parents' 2016 federal income tax return, if already prepared
- Records of untaxed income received by you and your parents in 2016 for example, Social Security, TANF, veteran's benefits, or military or clergy allowances
- Current bank statements, if you and/ or your parents have a bank account
- List of college or universities that you might be interested in attending during the 2018-2019 school year

Some students will need to bring additional records, such as Business or farm records, including current mortgage information, current records of stocks, bonds, or other investments.
